As the reunion weekend is also a long weekend in this area, accommodations are already tight so be sure to make your arrangements as soon as possible.

The Town of Kamsack is allowing persons to book any vacant town owned lot for camper/trailer parking. For more information or to book a lot, please contact Russ Brunt at 542-2458.

We have some exciting news in our area. Both Duck Mountain Lodge and Northern Lights Country Inn are under new ownership/management. Both locations are undergoing major repairs and upgrades right now. All will be available in time for the reunion. Duck Mountain Resorts Inc will have 10 condo units, 21 rooms and 11 cabins available. Reservations are being taken now at 542-3466. Duck Mountain Mee May Hillside Lodge will have 10 rooms and reservations are by calling (___watch for update___)

Duck Mountain Provincial Park is currently taking Reserve-A-Site requests online as of January 1st by using www.saskparks.net and clicking on reservations. One hundred sites are under this system. Others are first come, first serve basis. The first date for mail in or walk in reserve-a-site is June 1st.

Duck Mountain Motel in Kamsack is at this time almost booked full. They will only put one or two on a waiting list. They have three trailer sites left in their campground at this time due to construction crew reservations. Phone 542-2656 for reservation information.
