

A Bylaw of the Town of Kamsack in the Province of Saskatchewan to create a bylaw for Municipal Fees for services and products.

Short Title

1. This Bylaw may be cited as the Fees Bylaw.

A BYLAW TO AUTHORIZE CHARGING FEES FOR VARIOUS SERVICES AND PRODUCTS

WHEREAS, the Council of the Town of Kamsack considers it desirable and expedient to authorize the charging of fees for various municipal services and products;

NOW THEREFORE, The Council of the Town of Kamsack in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

2. Definitions:

(a) "Municipality"

shall mean the Town of Kamsack

(b) "Council"

shall mean the duly elected council for the Town of Kamsack

(c) "Customer"

shall mean any natural person or persons who received the service. Could be an individual, sole proprietorship, partnership, corporation, trust, joint venture, or any incorporated or

unincorporated entity or association of any nature.

- This Bylaw shall apply to any customer who requires goods or services supplied by the Municipality and provided in this bylaw.
- 4. The fees and charges set out in the following Schedules attached to and forming part of this Bylaw are hereby imposed:
