# A BYLAW IN THE TOWN OF KAMSACK, IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN, TO RECOVER PROTECTIVE SERVICES COSTS WITHIN THE TOWN.

This bylaw may be cited as the "Protective Services Bylaw".

The Council of the Town of Kamsack, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1. In this bylaw:
  - a) "Administrator" shall mean the administrator of the municipality;
  - b) "Act" shall mean *The Municipalities Act*;
  - c) "Council" shall mean the council of the municipality;
  - d) "Municipality" shall mean the The Town of Kamsack.
- 2. The cost of fire prevention, suppression and emergency response services may be charged directly on the persons who receive the service in accordance with Schedule "A" which is attached to and forming part of this bylaw.
- 3. The Council may authorize to add to the taxes of any property owned by the person referenced in Section 2 of this bylaw, any amount which remains unpaid 30 days after the person has been invoiced for said services as per Section 369 of the Act.
- 4. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on final passing thereof.

#### SCHEDULE "A" OF BYLAW NO. 13/2020

## **Primary Fire Response**

-Pumper Truck - \$750. for first hour of response and \$500./hour for every hour thereafter. \$250. for first hour of response and \$125./hour for every hour thereafter. \$350. for first hour of response and \$175./hour for every hour thereafter.

Mileage charge - \$1.75/travelled kilometer.

### **Costs for Fire Fighters**

-Fire Chief - \$40./hour -Deputy Fire Chief - \$40./hour -FireFighters - \$25./hour

#### **Other Fees**

- -Rescue services will be billed out according to Saskatchewan Urban Municipalities Association (SUMA) Rescue Services Fund rates.
- -Fire Inspection Services \$50./hour + mileage.
- -Any and all materials, including extra equipment needed during a response shall be billed out at  $\cos t + 10\%$
